



Present Perfect

Affirmative Sentences

Rules: Subject + has/have + V3 + object +...

Note: V3 means the Third form of the verb

Examples

- I have served.
- She has served.
- We have served.
- They have served.
- He has done his homework.
- She has washed the clothes.
- The rain has stopped.
- You have helped us.
- We have reached home.
- He has completed my work.



Present Perfect

Negative Sentences

Rules: Subject + has not / have not + object +...

Note: V3 means the Third form of the verb

Examples

- I have not served.
- He has not served.
- We have not served.
- He has not taken breakfast.
- She has not combed her hair.
- You have not taken breakfast.
- They have not taken breakfast.
- The carpenter has not made a chair.
- He has not told a lie.
- Artist has not painted the picture.



Present Perfect

Interrogative Sentences

Rules: Has / Have + subject + V3+ Object +..?

Note: V3 means the Third form of the verb

Examples

- Has he served?
- Have you served?
- Have they served?
- Has he won the match?
- Has he washed the clothes?
- Have they read the story?
- Have they changed the clothes?
- When have we sent the letter?
- Why has he gone to Lahore?
- How have they crossed the river
